32. The school shall apply for further Extension of Provisional Affiliation 'on online' through www.cbseaff.nic with prescribed fee and other essential documents as per the time period given by the board in this regard before the expiry of the date of provisional affiliation otherwise penalty as per rules will be charged for late execution of application.

The Board shall not be responsible for any consequences in case class IX/X/XII/XII is started without obtaining the prior approval of the Board and without following the Affiliation Byelaws.

41. It is mandatory for every affiliated school to become a member in the local Sahodaya of CBSE schools.

- 42. In case of established violation of Affiliation Bye laws, directions given in the circulars and any of the above mentioned conditions by the school, the school would be liable for disaffiliation under Chapter V, Rule No. 17 of Affiliation Byelaws.
- 43. Some of the important rules to be adhered to by the school were given above for drawing specific attention of the school authorities. However, the school authorities are required to acquaint themselves regarding the rules contained in Affiliation, Examination Bye-laws and circulars issued by the Board from time to time. Any laxity in following rules/instructions of the Board will lead to action against school as per Rule 17 of Affiliation Bye-laws.

44. The school is required to contact the concerned Regional Office of CBSE for allotment of school number and password

for online Registration of candidates.

45. The school is required to submit Recognition certificate issued by State Education Department from class 1st to 8th within a period of one year.

46. The school is required to submit EPF challan in the name of the school within 30 days.
